All 1099 dividend information is included on the bottom of your year end statement. There will NOT be a separate mailing with this information, so keep your December statement for tax reporting purposes!

There is only one thing more exciting than calculating your tax refund: actually receiving it! Now you can receive your refund quickly and safely with direct deposit to your credit union account. It's easy! Just fill in the requested information on the refund section of your tax return. Provide our credit union routing number (244280107), your account number, and indicate where you would like the deposit made (savings or checking).
